# DRAGON CUP 2018 REGULATIONS

#### A. DATE AND PLACE

The Dragon Cup will be held from 1st – 2nd December 2018 in Wolfsburg, Germany.

#### **B. VENUE**

Neue Halle der Bezirkssportanlage, Schwimmbad, 38442 Wolfsburg (Fallersleben)

# C. COMPETITION EVENTS

Traditional Taolu incl. Kungfu-Styles and Taiji forms, duel and group events. Events as stated in the entry form.

#### D. QUALIFICATIONS

All athletes with relevant knowledge of traditional Taolu routines. No athletes representing a country/nation are admitted. Official teams from member federations of EWUF and IWUF are admitted.

# E. Entry

Entry document (excel file) should be submitted via e-mail by 16<sup>th</sup> September 2016 the latest. Correct completion of the form shall be ensured. The final entry form shall be submitted to:

Entries submitted after 17<sup>th</sup> November 2018, 24.00p.m. will be subject to late-entry fee of 30,-EUR per routine and person.

Entries after 24<sup>rd</sup> November 2018 will not be accepted.

#### F. ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

Registration will take place 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018 from 9:00 – 9:45 a.m. at the designated registration point at the entrance of the sports hall.

All athletes should register there. Teams are requested to register their athletes at once.

#### **G. OPENING CEREMONY**

The opening ceremony will start at 10:00 – 10:30 p.m., 1st December 2018

#### H. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Each team may submit one taolu judge with relevant knowledge and experience in judging competitions.

Technical officials' details may be provided on the relevant section in the entry form. Judges may wear DWF official clothing or black trousers with white shirt.





All judges are requested to meet 1st September 2016 at 9:00 a.m. in front of the head judges' table.

#### I. PLACING AND AWARDS

- 1st place Gold medal and certificate
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place Silver medal and certificate
- 3rd place Bronze medal and certificate
- 4<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> place certificate
- Duel and group events as above for each athlete.

# COMPETITION

#### A. COMPETITION EVENTS

All traditional single routines. Duel events with two to three athletes. Team events from three athletes onwards.

# **B. PARTICIPATING METHODS**

No limits for number of team athletes.

One athlete can enter only three single events, one duel event and one team event.

#### C. COMPETITION METHODS

- 1. Competition will be conducted in accordance with the regulations of the International Wushu Federation from 2010, which will be adapted to the German standard:
  - Routine time for traditional Kungfu bare handed and apparatus events for adults and the group U18 must not be below one minute.
  - Routine time for traditional Taiji bare handed routines must not exceed 6 Min. and weapon routines must not exceed 4 Min.
  - For basic and compulsory routines there is no time limit.
  - Content of traditional routines with no specific guidelines.
  - Duel events for the groups U 9, U 12 and U 15 with no time limits.
  - Group events up to U15 must not be below 60 seconds, U15 plus at least 3 minutes.
  - Group events have to be accompanied by music.
- 2. Age categories for single events:
  - a. Youth U 9, U 12, U 15, U 18,
  - b. Adults U 45, U60, 60+
- 3. Age categories for duel and team events:

Group (A) U 9 + U 12 Group (B) U 12 + U 15,

Group (C) U 15 + U 18 Group (D) Women + Men

Gender can be mixed.

- 4. The traditional routines of Shaolin Kempo, Chen Tao Wushu, Ku Tae Ka Do, Kong Shou Dao etc. participate in an extra category; "Weitere chinesische Kungfu Stile" (no time limit)
- 5. Groups with less than five athletes may be put together appropriately.
- 6. Number of judges may vary.

#### D. COSTUMES

For traditional routines athletes must wear appropriate clothing matching to each discipline.
